DAY 1 : COLOMBO - GALLE

Proceed from Colombo to Galle (appr. 03 hrs on Galle Road)

Enroute visit the Sea Turtle Hatchery in Kosgoda



This is the oldest conservation and research project started in Sri Lanka in early 1978. It was at a time when all 7 species of sea turtles were on the endangered list. Of the 7 species, 5 of the species were found to be frequenting the beaches of the southern coast of Sri Lanka where they beached, to lay their eggs. These eggs were collected by the villagers and sold in the open market.

Visit the Madu Ganga



The Madu Ganga (river) holds a treasure trove of unique attractions for the keen explorer. From the aromatic Cinnamon Island to the rich mangroves that line the river, home to a variety of endemic flora and fauna, the river is a must visit during your holiday on the southern coast of Sri Lanka.

Enjoy a city Tour of Galle



Galle, the epic Southern capital, is the intersection where classic Dutch architecture meets a tropical setting creating a vivid atmosphere in beauty. Walk the Dutch-haunted streets listening to the creaks of wooden saloon doors and observe how European architecture mingles with South Asian traditions today flooding cultural enthusiasts on a global scale.

Visit the Maritime Museum



Maritime Museum is the only museum which raises awareness to the public on marine biological and anthropological aspects of the Southern coastal area. It is located in the old Dutch warehouse of the fort of Galle, built in 1671. The museum was open to the public on 9th May 1992.

View the Stilt Fisherman of Koggala



Koggala, renowned for its splendid coastal conditions, has been the perfect place for stilt fishing. Silhouettes of fishermen perched on vertical poles with crossbars, waiting for its daily catch – a beautiful and picture perfect spectacle.



Visit the Martin Wickramasinghe Folk Museum

The house in which Martin Wickramasinghe was born has inspired the Martin Wickramasinghe Trust to establish a Folk Museum Complex, surrounded by a restored ecosystem planted with hundreds of varieties of indigenous trees and shrubs in which bird life abounds. The house and the surroundings bring to life a little part of the Koggala which is so vividly depicted in Wickramasinghe's writings.

Visit the Athukorala Tea Factory



Established in 1991, Athukorala Tea presents the finest of Pure Ceylon Tea to its customers. The Athukorala Tea Factory is located in Pitigala Southern Sri Lanka and is open and welcome to all visitors keen to learn about the intricate process of producing the best cup.

Visitors to the Athukorala Tea Factory can observe step-by step how fresh tea leaves are then cut from the plantation's tea fields and then transported to the factory where they are later subject to withering, rolling, fermenting, drying and then finally sorting.
