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**DAY 1 : COLOMBO – KANDY**

**Proceed from Colombo to Kandy (appr. 03 hrs & 30 Min)**

Afterwards, fine tune your evening by stepping to the beat of traditional music & drumming amplified by a **cultural show** enhancing the rich and vibrant culture of the wonder of Asia, Sri Lanka.

Last ruled by King Sri Wickrama Rajasinghe - before it was brought under the British rule in 1815, Kandy - the world heritage Site & last royal capital of Sri Lankan kings - crafts an array of culture, history and the globe. A stroll across this small lakeside town, cradled among the misty hills, will feature the Kandy city center, bundled with latest and world class brands, bazaar, an arts & crafts center, walk in color as you glide through fresh fruits and vegetables in the Kandy market.

**Visit a gem museum & lapidary** to view a demonstration and explanation the cutting and polishing process of gems.

## Visit the Botanical Garden



Royal Botanic Gardens, Peradeniya are about 5.5 km to the west of the city of Kandy in the central province of Sri Lanka. In 2016, the garden was visited by 1.2 million locals and 400,000 foreign visitors. It is near the Mahaweli River (The longest river in Sri Lanka). It is renowned for its collection of orchids. The garden includes more than 4000 species of plants, including orchids, spices, medicinal plants and palm trees. Attached to it is the "National Herbarium of Sri Lanka".

Most of these places have a secure facility at the entrance for visitors to leave behind shoes and slippers for a very small fee
