DAY 1 : COLOMBO – KANDY

Proceed from Colombo to Kandy (appr. 03 hrs & 30 Min)

Visit Peradeniya Botanical Garden



Royal Botanic Gardens, Peradeniya are about 5.5 km to the west of the city of Kandy in the central province of Sri Lanka. In 2016, the garden was visited by 1.2 million locals and 400,000 foreign visitors. It is near the Mahaweli River (The longest river in Sri Lanka). It is renowned for its collection of Orchids. The garden includes more than 4000 species of plants, including Orchids, Spices, medicinal plants and palm trees. Attached to it is the "National Herbarium of Sri Lanka".



Visit the Sri Dalada Maligawa where guests can experience an ancient Kandyan legacy engraved around its crown jewel, the Temple of the sacred tooth relic of Lord Buddha.

In the evening step to the beat of traditional music & drumming amplified by **a cultural show** enhancing the rich and vibrant culture of the wonder of Asia, Sri Lanka.

On route, visit the Ramboda Waterfalls.

Dinner and Overnight stay at Mahaweli Reach hotel, Kandy.

DAY 2 : KANDY - NUWARA ELIYA

Breakfast at Mahaweli Reach Kandy,

Explore the city of Kandy with a shopping tour

Kandy - the world heritage Site & last royal capital of Sri Lankan kings - crafts an array of culture, history and heritage in the minds of visitors across the globe. Experience an ancient Kandyan legacy engraved around its crown jewel,

Visit the Kandy city center - bundled with latest and world class brands, bazaar, an arts & crafts center, walk in color as you glide through fresh fruits and vegetables in the Kandy market.

Visit a gem museum & lapidary to view a demonstration and explanation the cutting and polishing process of gems.

Thereafter, proceed from Kandy to Nuwara Eliya. (appr. 2hrs & 45 Min)



Ramboda Falls is 109 m (358 ft) high and the eleventh tallest waterfall in Sri Lanka and the 729th tallest waterfall in the world. It is situated in Pussellawa area, on the A5 highway at Ramboda Pass. The waterfall is formed by the Panna Oya which is a tributary of Kothmale Oya. The falls have an elevation of 945 m (3,100 ft) above sea level.

Visit a Tea Plantation

On route, visit the Ramboda Waterfalls.



Nuwara Eliya, it's all about tea! Sri Lanka is the fourth-largest producer of tea in the world (behind China, India, and Kenya). Sri Lanka exports almost 350,000 tons of tea leaves a year. While the first plantation was in Kandy, Nuwara Eliya has become the hub for all things tea.

Misty steep roads, twisting through lush green blankets of tea bushes in a cool climate, remind visitors that they are within the range of the renowned British colonial retreat, Nuwara Eliya. Augmented by an English countryside atmosphere, the city of light - once governed by English & Scottish planters - is still studded with colonial bungalows, hedgerows & one of the finest 18-hole golf courses in the world.

A sightseeing tour of the Nuwara Eliya town in the evening.

Dinner and overnight Stay at Jetwing St Andrews Nuwara Eliya.

Visit Seetha Amman Kohvil



The Seetha Amman Temple in Seetha Eliya has been constructed in what is believed to be the last location Sita was held captive by Ravana. It is possibly the only temple in the world to be dedicated to Sita, and is extremely popular amongst the Hindu community, as well as tourists.

Hakgala Botanical Garden



This garden was established in 1861 for the purpose of experimentation and promotion of Cinchona cultivation in Sri Lanka and subsequently Tea cultivation. Today it stands as a fine masterpiece of natural landscape with many features providing educational opportunities, especially on hill country landscape gardening, floriculture and montane flora.

Proceed from Nuwara Eliya to Colombo via Hatton & Kitulgala. (appr. 5 hrs)

On route pass by St. Clair's & Devon waterfalls.
